Silver Copay Change Summary

Effective July 1, 2010, some of the Healthy Kids Silver copays will change. All of the benefits that had a \$5 copay will now have a \$10 copay. Also, some of the benefits will have two levels of copays known as Tier 1 copayments and Tier 2 copayments. The Tier 1 copayment is lower than the Tier 2 copayment.

The chart below shows only the covered benefits that will have a copay change. If you do see the benefit listed below, your cost sharing will remain the same as what is indicated on the current Harvard Pilgrim Health Care Summary of Benefits.
