



## Silver & Buy-In Copay Changes 2010

### Healthy Kids Silver

Effective July 1, 2010, some of the Healthy Kids Silver copays have changed. All of the benefits that had a \$5 copay will now have a \$10 copay. Also, some of the benefits have two levels of tiered copays. The chart below shows only the covered benefits that have a copay change.

### Healthy Kids Buy-In

Starting with July 2010 benefits, the Healthy Kids Buy-In premium has increased to \$205 per child per month. This rate is set for one year through June 2011. Some of the copays have also changed for this program effective July 1, 2010. The chart below shows only the covered benefits that have a copay change.
